



The goal of this year's Summer Reading challenge is to encourage children of the Groves community to read or listen to books during the summer so they can maintain and improve good reading skills.

**First log is due June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021**

**Reading logs are to be turned in every Friday**

**Deadline for the last reading log will be July 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2021**

**Awards given July 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021**

**There are five reading divisions:**

**Read to me (any age to Pre-K)**

**Kindergarten – 1<sup>st</sup> grade**

**2<sup>nd</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> grade**

**4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade**

**Teen reading is for children 12 and up**

T-shirts will be given to the first 150 children who sign up between 3 PM and 7 PM in the library. Reading bags will also be give upon registration.

Record each book read appropriately on your reading log - one book per line. Library staff will record your books read each week. Do not call or email the library to add titles.

There will be a small prize given to children who return their reading logs. Each child who turns in a reading log on Friday will have their name put in a drawing for a Notable Reader yard sign.

Awards will be given to the top three readers of each category July 30<sup>th</sup>. Parents will be contacted.
